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MAINTENANCE REPORT

PETER RETTERETH #66 REGULATED DRAIN

TIPPECANOE COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD

The Peter Rettereth was originally established by the Tippecanoe County Superior Court, Case No. 9329 in 1909. The Drain and its watershed are located in Sections 31 and 32 of Township 24 North and Range 3 West in the political township of Washington and Sections 5 and 6 of Township 23 North and Range 3 West in the political township of Perry, Tippecanoe County, Indiana.

The Peter Rettereth Drain Maintenance Fund was established by the Tippecanoe County Drainage Board on April 6, 1972.

There are approximately 8800 lineal feet of main and branch tile, ranging in size from 6 inch to 24 inch which is all to be maintained by this maintenance fund. There is no open ditch associated with this county regulated drain. The tile outlets into the road side ditch of C.R. 450 North. The watershed contains 372.760 acres.

It is the judgement of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor that a sum of \$17,776.00 is needed to maintain and improve the existing tile system. The Maintenance Fund is currently \$2,388.25 in the red.

An assessment of \$5.50 per acre and a \$20.00 minimum over an 8 year collection period is recommended. This will generate \$17,069.04 over an 8 year period.

It is the professional opinion of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor this rate increase will allow for the continued tile maintenance work and ensure that monies will be generated for future maintenance on this system.
