MAINTENANCE REPORT

GUSTAVE SWANSON #76 REGULATED DRAIN

TIPPECANOE COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD

JUNE 30, 2015

The Gustave Swanson was originally established by the Tippecanoe County Superior Court, Case No. 823 in 1915. The drain and its watershed are located in Sections 7, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of Township 21 North and Range 3 West in the political township of Lauramie, Tippecanoe County, Indiana.

The Gustave Swanson maintenance fund was first established by the Tippecanoe County Drainage Board on July 6, 1971.

There are approximately 46,250 lineal feet of tile in this system, and no open ditch associated with or maintained by this maintenance fund. The tile outlets into the Moses Baker County Regulated Drain and maintained open ditch. The watershed contains 1253.18 acres.

It is the judgement of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor that a sum of \$66,000.00 is needed to maintain and improve the existing tile system.

An assessment of \$6.00 per acre and a \$20.00 minimum over an eight (8) year period is recommended. This will generate \$61,453.63 over an eight (8) year period.

It is the professional opinion of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor this rate increase will allow for the much needed tile maintenance work and ensure that monies will be generated for future maintenance on this system.
