2. You will be given a time and date to arrive for Intake processing.
Our appointments are set for Monday & Wednesdays from: 9am - Noon

Prior to your arrival you should:

1. Read the Handbook on the website

- 2. Remove from your home any drugs, paraphernalia, weapons, alcohol
- 3. Have a Tuberculosis (TB) test scheduled or completed
- 3. The day you sign on:
  - a. Do NOT be late

You will be charged a reschedule fee or the judge may be notified of non-compliance

b. Do NOT show up intoxicated in any form

You will be turned away and possible police involvement may occur.

- c. If you do NOT have a valid license, do NOT drive, you will be charged with a new crime by Law Enforcement.
- d. Expect to be at TCCC for a minimum of three (3) hours for sign-on.
- e. You will sign the complete handbook packet.
- f. You may possibly have your DNA taken via mouth swab.
- g. You will be assigned a case manager at this time.
- h. You will have your GPS unit placed on you at this time.
- i. You will create your first week's schedule

Please bring your work schedule, doctor appointments, 12-step meetings, and court obligations

IF IT'S NOT ON YOUR SCHEDULE, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DO IT
