

**TIPPECANOE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**REGULAR MEETING**  
**January 20, 2015**

The Tippecanoe County Commissioners met on Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in the Tippecanoe Room in the County Office Building. Commissioners present were: Vice President David S. Byers and Commissioner Tracy A. Brown. Also present were: Attorney Doug Masson, Auditor Bob Plantenga, Commissioners' Assistant Paula Bennett, and Recording Secretary Tillie Hennigar. President Thomas P. Murtaugh was absent.

Vice President Byers called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

- Commissioner Brown moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held January 5, 2015 and the Executive Session meetings held December 18, 2014 and January 2, 2015, second by Commissioner Byers; motion carried.

**PRESENTATION OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE VOUCHERS AND PAYROLL**

- Commissioner Brown moved to approve the accounts payable vouchers for December 31, 2014 and January 1 through 20, 2015 and payroll vouchers for January 16, 2015 as submitted without exception, second by Commissioner Byers; motion carried.

**Petition for Vacation of Right-of-Way, First Reading, a portion of Railroad Street in Colburn, Indiana. Petitioner Danny Pattengale**

Highway Assistant Executive Director Spencer presented a petition to vacate a portion of Railroad Street in Colburn, filed by Danny Pattengale. The utility company has verified there are no utilities in the way; it has been advertised in the newspaper; and everything is in order for the first reading and the second reading if you choose.

Commissioner Byers invited public comment in favor of or opposed to the vacation. There were none.

Assistant Director Spencer presented a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond for Yates Construction, the contractor for the reconstruction of Bridge No. 17. The bridge was closed yesterday and is being demolished today.

MITS Chief Information Officer Sturgeon said the agreement with Value Payment Systems enables tax payments through the new Beacon portal. The amount charged is 2.75% per transaction with the exception of Visa debit cards which will charge \$3.95. There is no fee to the County for the service. There is an option of a credit card machine in the Treasurer's office at a later date.




***PUBLIC COMMENT***
