

ITVAP 2020-2022 Contract Addendum
VOCA Safe Place

Indiana Youth Services Association and Tippecanoe County Youth Services.

Purpose: Indiana Youth Services Association (IYSA) received a Victims of Crime Assistance grant from Indiana Criminal Justice Institute to create the Indiana Trafficking Victims Assistance Program (ITVAP.) ITVAP will identify and provide comprehensive services to youth (24 and under) victims of trafficking or sexual exploitation by creating 10 regional coalitions and engaging community partners across the state. ITVAP will partner with existing IPATH task forces, the Indiana State Police, the youth services bureaus and Safe Place programs across the state and expand Safe Place services to new counties to strengthen services already available and work to establish a network of services where none currently exists.

Rationale: In order to expand Safe Place services and incorporate existing programs into the IPTVAP service delivery plan, IYSA will provide additional funding to Tippecanoe County Youth Services for each grant fiscal cycle, October 2020-September 2022 to provide specific training for identification and service provision for trafficked or sexually exploited youth, and provide materials and support to the agency when a victim has been identified in their service area.

Agency Requirements:

To received the additional funding through the VOCA grant, Tippecanoe County Youth Services will agree to the following:

1. Utilize the trafficking and sexual exploitation assessment tool provided by IYSA with all Safe Place youth.
2. Notify the ITVAP Regional Coalition Coordinator of all identified or suspected cases of trafficked or sexually exploited youth served by the agency.
3. Enter or share data of identified or suspected cases of trafficked or sexually exploited youth into the ITVAP online database.
4. Include education about exploitation and human trafficking in the Safe Place youth presentations and enter activity in the ITVAP database Outreach Activities as Safe Place HT information.

This addendum goes into effect October 1, 2020 once the contract addendum with signatures is returned. Reimbursement to the agency will occur upon completion of the (applicable) requirements listed above.
