"SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS WEEK"

MARCH 14th – 20th, 2021

WHEREAS: The months of March through June present the highest risk for severe thunderstorms and tornadoes to strike Tippecanoe County; and

WHEREAS: Tippecanoe County is located within the nation's "Tornado Belt", becoming a prime target of devastating tornado outbreaks and other types of severe weather; and

WHEREAS: A statewide tornado warning exercise will be held on March 16, 2021 between 10:00 and 10:30 AM EDT for the purpose of testing communications systems, equipment and procedures; and

WHEREAS: During this week, the Tippecanoe County Emergency Management is emphasizing its safety procedures involving tornado activity;
