

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-10-CM

ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF
SOFT BODY ARMOR AND VEST CARRIER
FROM THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE

WHEREAS, Tippecanoe County has hired a police officer who formerly worked with the City of Lafayette;

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette is willing to transfer ownership of soft body armor and vest carrier (bulletproof vest) conforming to the specifications required by the Tippecanoe County Sheriff's Department to equip the officer; and

WHEREAS, Tippecanoe County is willing to pay seven hundred and ninety-five dollars (\$795) for said bulletproof vest; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 5-22-22-10 permits the exchange of property between governmental bodies for any amount of property or cash as agreed upon by the governmental bodies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County accepts the transfer of the bulletproof vest from the City of Lafayette in exchange for payment by the County to the City in the amount of seven hundred and ninety-five dollars (\$795); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
