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**BACKGROUND AND REQUEST:**

The FY 2021 & 2022 UPWP was adopted on April 8, 2021. The Area Plan Commission includes CityBus' planning projects in the UPWP for continuity and comprehensiveness. The Greater Lafayette Public Transportation Corporation, or CityBus, requests an amendment to include a planning project in the UPWP. This amendment adds the following project to the FY 2021 & 2022 UPWP:

**Planning: Feasibility Study/Engineering Services - \$300,000, Project # LAF-21-013**

CityBus will invest \$240,000 in Section 5307 funds for a feasibility study and engineering services to convert the current production area to revenue and support vehicle storage and preventative maintenance area for the property at 2800 Duncan Road.
