If you are seeking evidence or information about your case but from a person, agency, corporation, etc. who is not a party to your case, you must instead file a “subpoena duces tecum” and get the approval of the Judge to serve this “subpoena” on the non-party.

A “subpoena duces tecum” form is available at the Clerk’s Office or online.

“Verified” means that by signing and submitting this Motion, you swear or affirm under oath and under penalties for perjury that all the answers and information are true and accurate.

This form has both a Motion and an Order.

→ You must fully complete and sign the Motion.

→ You must complete only the top half of the Order.

Print and bring both forms to court.
