

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-07-CM
AMENDING TIPPECANOE COUNTY CODE
REPEALING SECTION 31.035
ADDING NEW SECTION 31.035

CARY HOME ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County (the Commissioners) established the Cary Home Advisory Board (the Board) pursuant to Ordinance 2000-63-CM, adopted August 21, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners now desire to amend the membership of the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, Indiana, that the Tippecanoe County Code be amended by repealing Section 31.035 and adding a new Section 31.035 reading as follows:

§ 31.035 ESTABLISHMENT; MEMBERS.

(A) There is hereby created a board to be known as the Cary Home Advisory Board which shall consist of the following persons:

- (1) The following members, each of which shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County:
 - A. One member of the Board of County Commissioners;
 - B. Two members of law enforcement agencies of the County (one of which individuals shall be from the Tippecanoe County Sheriff's Department);
 - C. Two members of the Tippecanoe County Office of the Indiana Department of Child Services (one of which individuals shall be directly involved with emergency child placement);
 - D. one member of the Friends of Cary Home; and
 - E. one member of the community;
- (2) One representative of Lafayette School Corporation appointed by Lafayette School Corporation;

- (3) Two township trustees to be appointed by the Tippecanoe County Trustees Association;
 - (4) One member of the County Council to be appointed by the County Council;
 - (5) One member of the Tippecanoe County Probation Department, to be appointed by the Judge of the Tippecanoe Circuit Court;
- (B) Each member shall be appointed for a term of one year commencing on January 1 of each year and shall serve until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.
- (C) The Cary Home Advisory Board shall be an advisory body that will meet on a regular basis not less than four times a year, and will review the operations and procedures being followed and utilized at the Jessie Levering Cary Home. The Cary Home Advisory Board shall make written recommendations pertaining thereto to the Board of County Commissioners.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signing.




