

ORDINANCE 96-32-CM

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC
CONTROL ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS AND RAILWAYS**

WHEREAS, the officials of Tippecanoe County became aware of the fact that the State of Indiana intends to close State Highway 28 bridge West of Romney for repairs on July 1, 1996; and

WHEREAS, when similar closures have occurred in the past, most vehicles using State Highways ignore the official detours over State Highways, and use County Highways as a shortcut; and

WHEREAS, such shortcuts shall take the traveling public on County Highways that encompass the following locations, and that such locations require regulatory signs as listed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Tippecanoe County finds, declares and proclaims that there is a necessity requiring the adoption of this Ordinance and requiring that its date of effectiveness be July 1, 1996; and

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE Sections 8-17-1-40, 9-21-1-2 and 9-21-1-3, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, upon the basis of an Engineering and Traffic Investigation, that the regulatory signs, as listed below, are reasonable and safe and are in conformance with the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, Indiana that:

The above recitals hereby are incorporated in and made a part of this Ordinance

The following Stop signs shall be established as follows:

- A.) The Yield sign on County Road 1150 South at County Road 125 West is to be changed to a 30" High Intensity Stop sign.
- B.) A 30" High Intensity Stop sign will be installed on the East approach of County Road 925 South at County Road 100 West.

The following Railroad Crossing Stop signs shall be established as follows:

- A.) County Road 925 South at the CSXT Railroad Crossing East of County Road 100 West shall have 30" High Intensity Stop signs.
- B.) County Road 1200 South at the CSXT Railroad Crossing East of County Road 125 West shall have 30" High Intensity Stop signs.

PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

- 1. A person who violates the signage set forth in this Ordinance commits a Class C infraction.

The Sheriff's Department is to be notified of all the above traffic control installations and changes.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be effective July 1, 1996.
