

ORDINANCE 94-25-CL

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COVERAGE OF LIABILITY CLAIMS FROM INMATES/PRISONERS INCARCERATED IN THE TIPPECANOE COUNTY JAIL AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FUND FOR SAID CLAIMS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Tippecanoe, in conjunction with the Tippecanoe County Sheriff are responsible for the providing of a facility to house inmate/prisoners in Tippecanoe County as well as the operation of said facility, and;

WHEREAS, the inmate/prisoners of said jail facility assert claims against the County which result in liability exposure for Tippecanoe County, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Tippecanoe, in conjunction with the Tippecanoe County Sheriff are of the opinion that coverage in the form of a self-insurance fund should be created to fund rightful claims from inmate/prisoners as to injuries suffered by and/or illnesses incurred by inmates/prisoners in the Tippecanoe County Jail.

WHEREAS, the Tippecanoe County Council is responsible for the establishment of self-insurance funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tippecanoe County Council, State of Indiana, a self-insurance liability fund for inmates/prisoners of the Tippecanoe County Jail be established for the purposes as previously set forth.






