

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-32-CM**  
**AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF 2011 DODGE CHARGER TO**  
**TIPPECANOE EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE**

**WHEREAS**, the Tippecanoe County Board of Commissioners has determined that it now owns a certain 2011 Dodge Charger with 131,000 miles which is no longer useable or useful to the County which had previously been used by the Tippecanoe County Sheriff's Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County desires to transfer ownership of the Dodge Charger to the Tippecanoe Emergency Ambulance Service ("TEAS") for use as a non-transporting EMS vehicle ("chase car"); and


**WHEREAS**, TEAS desires to accept the ownership of said Dodge Charger; and

**WHEREAS**, I.C. 5-22-22-1(c)(7) and IC 36-1-11-1(b)(7) permits the sale or lease of property by a governmental unit to an Indiana non-profit corporation organized for educational, literary, scientific, religious, or charitable purposes which is exempt from federal income taxation under 501 of the Internal Revenue Code without compliance with other laws applicable to the disposition of surplus personal property;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the 2011 Dodge Charger with VIN# 2B3CL1CG3BH565250 shall be transferred to TEAS for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), provided, however, that TEAS shall pay all costs associated with the transfer; and


