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Maintenance Report
Martin V. Erwin #28 Regulated Drain
September 21, 2016

The Martin Erwin Drain per records found in the Surveyor's office was established and constructed per Surveyor's Drainage Record I Act 1889 Page 35. The Drain and its watershed are located in Section 5 of Township 23 North and Range 5 West in the political township of Shelby, Tippecanoe County, Indiana.

There are zero (0) lineal feet of open ditch and 1900 lineal feet of tile under maintenance. The tile outlets immediately north of Jackson Highway and terminates on the north side of Co. Rd. 350North. The watershed contains 61.28 acres.


The Martin Erwin drain maintenance fund was established by the Tippecanoe County Drainage Board on the 6th day of June, 1972.

It is the judgement of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor that a sum of \$13,200.00 is needed to maintain and improve the existing tile system.

An assessment of \$27.00 per acre and \$20.00 minimum over an eight (8) year period is recommended. This will generate \$ 13,395.56 over an eight (8) year period. Afterward the maintenance rate shall be lowered to \$10.00 per acre and a \$10.00 minimum with an eight (8) year cap.

It is the professional recommendation of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor that this rate increase is necessary to accomplish the desired tile maintenance work requested by landowners in the watershed. It will also ensure that monies will be generated for future maintenance work on this drainage system.
