Over the past year, City of Lafayette and Tippecanoe County have initiated a joint project to explore the potential benefits of various improvements to Elliott Ditch near your place of residence. Proposed stream improvement projects are being considered as part of a Capital Improvement Plan for Elliott Ditch which would be implemented over several years to address issues like stream bank erosion, invasive vegetation removal, and utility corridor protection. Christopher B. Burke Engineering, LLC is under contract with the City and the County to complete the engineering analyses as part of the Capital Improvement Plan.

To gather your valuable feedback on these important issues, the City and County would like to invite you to a public open house to present the various proposed improvement options for Elliott Ditch.
