The Tippecanoe County Highway Department will receive sealed bids to:

Furnish and Apply a 38% Calcium Chloride solution for dust control any place in the county as specified

Until the hour of 3:00 P.M. on the 10th day of March 2021 at the Highway Department, in the Tippecanoe County Office Building, Lafayette, Indiana. Bids will be opened and read aloud in the offices of the Highway Department.

Bids received after such time will be returned unopened.

Bids may be withdrawn prior to such time, but no bids shall be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) days thereafter.

All documents with each proposal shall be properly executed and addressed to the Highway Department of Tippecanoe County, State of Indiana.

GENERAL

The Successful Bidder shall furnish and apply a 38% Calcium Chloride solution for dust control at an average rate of 0.40 gallons/square yard, at locations as specified by the Tippecanoe County Highway Department.

Tippecanoe County Highway Department will provide support in this application with either detailed maps or riders to help the application process.

Daily activities shall be coordinated with the Tippecanoe Highway Department.

The work will be payed for complete in place at the accepted price per gallon.

The base bid per gallon shall include three mobilizations one initial mobilization and up to two remobilizations for touch ups. Additional mobilizations will be paid for at the unit price bid for "Additional Mobilizations".

The Successful Bidder shall indemnify and save harmless the local agency from any and all suits, costs and penalties or claims associated with the application.

The successful Proposer shall maintain and provide the Highway Department with proof of:

Contractor's Public Liability Insurance providing for a limit of \$500,000 for all damages arising out of bodily injuries to or death of one person and subject to that limit for each person, a total limit of \$1,000,000 for all damages arising out of bodily injuries to or death of two or more persons in any one occurrence, and regular Contractor's Property Damage Liability Insurance providing for a limit of \$500,000 for all damage arising out of injury to or destruction of property in any one occurrence and, subject to that limit for each occurrence, a total (or aggregate) limit of \$1,000,000 for all damages arising out of injury to or destruction of property during the policy period

The successful Bidderer shall comply with the County's

- Title VI Assurances
- Nondiscrimination Policies
- Nonsegregation
- Hours and Safety Standards
