PAYMENT METHODS

ESCROW: If your statement reads “For Informational Purposes Only”, our records indicate your tax is paid by a mortgage company through an escrow account and not by you. If this is an error, or you will pay off your mortgage during the year, please use this statement to make your payment.

ONLINE: Go to <https://www.tippecanoe.in.gov/503/Treasurer>, then scroll down to find the Beacon™ image. Payments made online are timely if made by midnight (EST) on the due date. A convenience fee will be charged for all online payments. Use the Chrome or Firefox browsers; Internet Explorer will not work.



Go directly to Beacon™ at www.beacon.schneidercorp.com to make a payment, reprint a mailed tax statement, and review other property information.

MAIL: Checks should be written to Tippecanoe County Treasurer and mailed to the address above. Payments are timely with a postmark on or before the due date. If mailed on the due date, we suggest requesting a hand-cancelled date stamp. Include a self-addressed, stamped envelope to receive your receipt.

IN PERSON: The office is open Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Parking is available in the County garage; use the entrance on Columbia Street. We accept cash, check, certified funds, and credit/debit cards. Card payments will be charged a convenience fee.

County offices will be closed April 7th for Good Friday.

DROP BOX: Place payments in the secure box located at the entrance of the County Office Building, 20 N 3rd Street. The drop box is checked daily and open year-round except for one week immediately following each installment due date.

STALEY CREDIT UNON: The branches at 1632 Union Street and 3553 Promenade Parkway accept property tax payments. Non-members are welcome. Open Saturdays. For lobby and drive-thru hours, visit www.staleyku.com/contact/. You **MUST** bring the tax statement payment coupon and cash or personal check.
