DRESS CODE and CONDUCT FOR COURT

As members of the community using Tippecanoe Superior Court 3, Juvenile Court, it is expected and required that you and your child appear in Court in appropriate clothing. It is also expected that you and your child behave appropriately.

The following rules must be followed for the professional integrity of the Court and the judicial process. All parents/guardians are expected to follow the dress code themselves and to make their children follow the dress code. All parents/guardians are expected to follow the conduct rules themselves and to make their children follow the conduct rules.

Failure to follow these rules may result in a continuance of your case or in other negative consequences.

UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING

SHORTS OF ANY KIND (including cut-offs), HALTER TOPS,
ANY CLOTHES (SHIRTS OR PANTS) with inappropriate messages/pictures,
SWEATSHIRTS, ANY CLOTHES (SHIRTS OR PANTS) that are torn (including
clothes purchased with tears already in them), UNTIED SHOE LACES,
BATHING SUITS OR BODY SUITS, HATS, FLIP FLOP SANDALS.

CONDUCT

Court is a formal proceeding and is recorded. Appropriate responses to questions by the Court shall be "yes" or "no". Chewing gum is not allowed in the Courtroom. Do not bring food or drinks into the Courtroom. Firearms and other weapons are not allowed in the Courtroom and will be taken by security.
